## **EARLY EDUCATION FUNDING**

All children with a birth date between 1<sup>st</sup> April 2003 and 30<sup>th</sup> April 2005 inclusive are eligible for Early Education Funding. Claim forms are being sent out this week. Please return your form as soon as possible.

Funding is available for up to 5 sessions per week. Children receive six terms of funding: three as three year olds and three as four year olds.

**We must point out that responsibility lies with individual parents to contact the office if they are eligible for the funding but have not received a claim form.**
