EARLY YEARS' FUNDING

All children with a birth date between 1st April 2005 and 30th April 2007 inclusive are eligible for Early Years' Funding. Claim forms will be sent out before the end of term. If you do not receive one, please contact the office. Completed forms should be returned to the Bursar by Tuesday 4th May 2010.

Funding is available for up to 5 sessions per week for three and four year olds.

We must point out that responsibility lies with individual parents to contact the office if they are eligible for the funding but have not received a claim form.
