EQUESTRIAN NEWS – TEAM QUALIFIES FOR NATIONALS AGAIN!



South Lee Equestrian Team had a very successful day at Norton Heath Equestrian Centre on Saturday. We took part in the Eastern Regional qualifier for the National Schools Association Show-Jumping competition.

We had two teams competing in the Novice (80cm) Class and they finished 1st and 5th. Issy Starr, Isabelle Upton and Annie Fulcher were in the team that won and Oliver Lawson, Rose Dunlop, Issy Starr and Isabelle Upton were in the team that came 5th. Isabelle also won the individual competition with a very speedy clear round! The winning team and Isabelle have qualified to represent South Lee in the National Finals at Addington Manor on 4th and 5th December.

We also had two teams competing in the Intermediate (90cm) class. The team with Annie, Isabelle and Issy in it came 3rd and the team with Rose, Issy and Isabelle in it came 4th. Individually, Isabelle won the class with another speedy round and Annie came 5th with a stylish double clear. Isabelle also qualified to represent South Lee in the National Finals at this height.

Well done to everyone who competed and to the parents and Mr Whipp for having a very long day supporting!
