### **FUND RAISING**

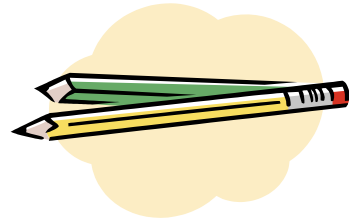
