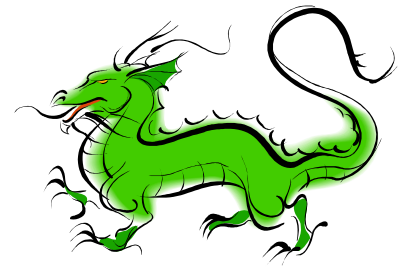
GREAT NORTH RUN
