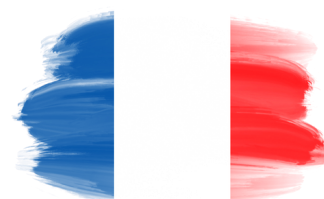

Valentine's Disco; doors opening from 5pm. Swans through to Year 8 welcome. Poster to follow.

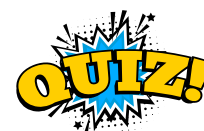
### Wednesday 1st March

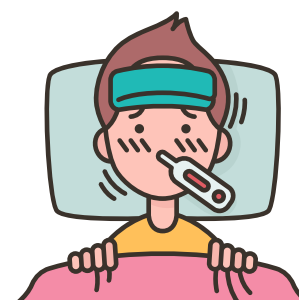

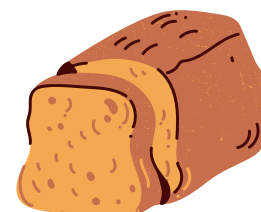
