Attendance and Absence

If your child is absent, please ensure you call us at 01284 754654 or email office@southlee.co.uk on the first day of absence. If we haven't heard from you by 9am, our School Secretary will be in touch to inquire about the reason for the absence. For subsequent days of absence, please continue to notify us by phone or email.

We advise parents to keep children at home until they have been symptom-free for 48 hours following sickness or diarrhoea.
