
## World Book Day

## Year 2 STEM - Coat for a Goat




As part of our topic on the Billy Goats Gruff, we are going to be making a 'coat for a goat'.

The children will need a favourite soft toy to measure up for its coat (it does NOT need to be a goat!).


## Year 2 Food Tech
