Chef Rachel's Corner



Summer is here, and what better way to celebrate than with another scrumptious recipe? Now that strawberries are in season, it's the perfect time to head down to your local Pick Your Own farm for a fun outing in the sunshine. You can pick your own juicy berries and even taste a few different varieties before choosing your favourites. Yum!

Summer Berry Crunch

Ingredients:

- Punnet of strawberries (as many or as few as you like)
- 500g full-fat Greek yogurt
- 90g oats
- 3 tbsp melted butter
- 50g light brown sugar



Let's Get Started:

- 1. First things first, let's get crunchy! Combine your oats, sugar, and melted butter, then spread them out on a tray lined with baking paper. Make sure to space them out nicely so they all get crispy in the oven. Pop them into a hot oven at 180 degrees for 10 minutes, giving them a little stir halfway through. Once they're golden and delicious, take them out and let them cool.
- 2. Now, let's assemble our masterpiece! Cut your strawberries into quarters and create a lovely thick layer at the bottom of your serving glasses. Spoon over your Greek yogurt, making sure to spread it out evenly. Then, for the pièce de résistance, sprinkle a generous layer of our homemade granola on top. Pro tip: Hold off adding the granola until you're ready to eat to keep that delightful crunch intact. And the best part? You can throw this dessert together on a whim whenever you're craving something sweet!
