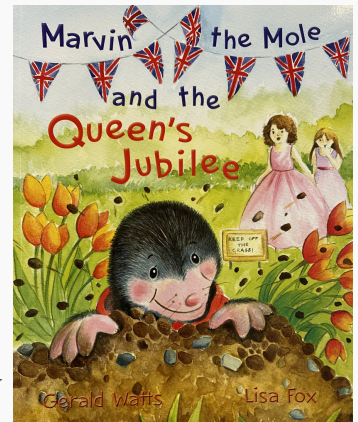


## Author Visit to Pupils in Reception - Year 4
